Project Description:

Internal refurbishment of Second floor laboratories including mechanical and electrical services.



Construction details:

Located on the University’s Bloomsbury site in the heart of London, T&B are pleased to be undertaking a complete refurbishment for UCL in the Christopher Ingold Building.

A complete strip out of existing fittings in the Turner Laboratories on the second floor of the Chemistry building will be undertaken and installation of new floors, walls and ceiling installed throughout. New laboratory furniture will be fitted along with specialist fume cupboards.



A stair lift will be put in to aid access to the floor and fire shutters installed to improve fire safety within the laboratories.

Retractable seating will be installed in the projector viewing area along with a new air handling unit on the roof.

Access to the building is restricted to a single location from the road and the building is remaining in full use whilst works are underway.
