Window replacements and concrete repairs

Construction details:

Located in Old Town Clapham London, Clapham Fire Station is a busy station incorporating four residential properties used for dormitories and offices. T&B contractors were employed by the LFEPA to replace the existing UPVC windows with Aluminium units.



During the course of the works the Fire Station had to remain fully operational, along with the supporting residential properties. This was achieved by careful planning and constant liaison with the station manager.

To ensure all four appliance bay doors were kept continuously operational T&B utilised a mastclimber to undertake the window renewals to the front elevation
