Project Description:

Construction of a standalone single storey building for new offices for the Paul Strickland Scanner Centre.

Construction details:

Located in the grounds of Mount Vernon Hospital, works were undertaken to build a new office block with state of the art IT facilities for the centres appointed fundraising team.



The construction of the pile raft structure included, brickwork and blocks work walls, factory manufactured roof trusses and metal stud and plaster internal partition walls. Complete decorations were undertaken throughout the new building.

In addition the project also included installation of a full air conditioning system and landscaping of the external grounds around the centre.
