**Project Description:**

Demolition of existing building, create new toilet, community hall, store and refurbish existing toilets.

**Construction details:**

Located in Colindale London, works were undertaken to build a new community hall at The Hyde Church.

The Project begun with the demolition and removal of the old existing bomb shelter in order to clear the site for the new extension.

Works have provided the church with a new community hall, new WC facilities, new kitchen, and 4 new meeting rooms.

Complete Mechanical and Electrical works were undertaken and Velux windows installed in the new extension which are electronically operated.

Disabled access was added with disabled ramps located at both entrances and throughout all areas.

The church remained fully operational throughout the construction programme and the Hyde Church were delighted with the new facilities.
