Project Description:

Refurbishment & alterations to the Rotunda building, part of Herschel Grammar School.

Construction details:

Recently taken over by Herschel Grammar School from Slough Borough Council; works were undertaken to The Rotunda building, a single storey circular building which will be used as a centre for delinquent teenagers.

Works involved structural alterations to internal walls with alterations and re-location of some internal partitions and associated joinery.

The Main entrance area was completely refurbished, with a new external canopy added and glass windows added. In addition new flooring was laid throughout the building and new plaster finishes carried out to some internal walls.

The structure is double height in the centre and this area, known as "the drum" was fully reglazed. Additional WC facilities were fitted and new mechanical and electrical services installed.
